"Appearance of the Risen Lord"

Lesson: John 21:1-14

GOLDEN TEXT:

"Jesus saith unto them, Come and dine. And none of the disciples durst ask Him, Who art thou? knowing that it was the Lord." — John 21:12

TODAY'S AIM:

"To see how the Lord Jesus helps the faith of His disciples.

INTRODUCING THE LESSON:

Today we study another and very important postresurrection appearance of the Lord Jesus to His disciples. Seven out of the remaining eleven of Jesus' disciples were together. This reminds us of the importance of being together as the Lord's followers. Simon Peter was their de facto leader in the absence of the Lord Jesus. It is true that Peter had also denied his Master three times during Jesus' trials, but even with his failure, Peter was a changed man, especially after the resurrection. We need to be constantly thankful for the fact that when the Lord Jesus saves us, He changes us from what we would be and used to be.

This Scripture, shows us that the Lord can deal with our basic fallen human nature and instill in us the desire to follow Him and do His will. Only as the Lord Jesus saves us and directs our lives can we do anything that will honor Him.

PRACTICAL POINTS:

1. Jesus' presence is with those who follow Him (John 21:1-3).
2. Do not become discouraged when it seems that your efforts are futile (John 21:4).
3. When you follow Jesus' directions, you will find what you need (John 21:5).
4. A good follower recognizes and appreciates the wisdom of his leader (John 21:6-7).
5. Jesus brings abundance where there was lack (John 21:8-9).
6. Jesus makes preparation for His children and provides for them (John 21:10-14).

CONCLUDING THE LESSON:

It is easy to see why these events were recorded for us. The lessons are obvious. It is true that the text records historical facts. However, it is also inescapable that this type of interaction between the Lord and His followers is the sort of thing we would expect from Him. We do not need, nor should we desire, to take direction of our own lives. We cannot possibly achieve the success or the fulfillment in life that Christ promises. Also, we are assured by these events that He rose from the dead and is the same marvelous Lord of miracles and of the ordinary events of life that He was so long ago.
