"Delegated Authority"

Lesson: Matthew 10:1-15

GOLDEN TEXT:

"When He had called unto Him His twelve disciples, He gave them power against unclean spirits, to cast them out, and to heal all manner of sickness and all manner of diseases." — Matthew 10:1

TODAY'S AIM:

"To see the facts of the authority the Lord Jesus has delegated."

INTRODUCING THE LESSON:

Wherever two or more people are gathered, the following questions naturally arise: "Who is in charge?" and "What authority does he or she have? Nowhere is this more important than in the spiritual realm. As fallible human beings, when we want to get something right, we like to quote an authority. We want to be sure we are doing and saying what is right. We can profit much from studying what the Lord Jesus did in His earthly ministry and what He continues to do in the time between His comings.

PRACTICAL POINTS:

1. Although we are not named with the twelve, we are called to follow God (Matthew 10:1-5).
2. Spiritual leaders are appointed to be servants of the people. God is the Master (Matthew 10:6-7).
3. When we are sent by God, the ministry that He entrusts to us will bless His people (Matthew 10:8).
4. True ministry requires personal sacrifice to meet the needs of others (Matthew 10:9-10).
5. Thank those who share God's blessings (Matthew 10:11-13).
6. We should take care of those who make sacrifices to serve us (Matthew 10:14-15).

CONCLUDING THE LESSON:

In the light of all that is happening in our day, it is apparent that the Lord's return must be very near. We are not part of the original apostles, but in this age of grace, we have been given much. We can give much, especially with the means of communication we have. We have the complete revelation of the entire Bible. We have the record of the death, burial, and resurrection of the Lord Jesus. We have the Great Commission and the empowerment of the indwelling Holy Spirit. In all this light that God has given us, we are rich indeed. We have the very love of the Lord Jesus to share with others. We have the brightest future and a home in heaven. We received freely, and we can give freely to others.

We may face persecution for sharing spiritual truth with others. Yet the value of lost souls for whom Christ died and His command to go into all the world and tell everyone about Him should impel us to do our part gladly and joyfully.
