“A Prophet Like Moses”

Lesson: Deuteronomy 18:9-22

GOLDEN TEXT:

“I will raise them up a Prophet from among their brethren, like unto thee, and will put My words in his mouth; and he shall speak unto them all that I shall command him.” — Deuteronomy 18:18

TODAY’S AIM:

“To remind us that God has called His children to live holy lives.”

INTRODUCING THE LESSON:

God is serious that His children follow Him and not get caught up in the shifting sands of cultural opinion. In this week’s lesson, we will see that He promised to send a prophet like Moses, a prophecy that was ultimately fulfilled by Jesus Christ. God has also anointed certain men and women to speak for Him to all people, calling them to repent and follow Christ. Are you listening to the prophetic Word of God, or are you more interested in what your friends think?

PRACTICAL POINTS:

1. We may be surrounded by people who live according to their own terms, but we must not follow their example (Deuteronomy 18:9-12).
2. The people of God are called to be vastly different from non-believers. Those differences should be noticeable (Deuteronomy 18:13-14).
3. God is responsible for elevating His people to leadership positions (Deuteronomy 18:15-16).
4. We must pay careful attention when the Word of God is preached (Deuteronomy 18:17-19).
5. Not everyone who claims to speak on God’s behalf is always being truthful (Deuteronomy 18:20-22).

CONCLUDING THE LESSON:

Just as the Israelites were commanded to listen to the voice of the prophet who spoke God’s word, we are to obey the word of Jesus. He is the Son of God, the Word made flesh (John 1:1, 14). Since Jesus is God in the flesh, He has authority over our lives. Being obedient to Him will result in great blessing, but rejecting His word will lead to judgment. As Christians, we should be gladly willing to do as Christ says, not out of obligation, but out of love and thanksgiving to the One who has given us eternal life.
