# "First Mission of the Twelve"

Lesson: Luke 9:1-10

#### **GOLDEN TEXT:**

"Then He called His twelve disciples together, and gave them power and authority over all devils, and to cure diseases. And He sent them to preach the kingdom of God, and to heal the sick." — Luke 9:1-2

## **TODAY'S AIM:**

"To learn that all disciples of Christ have been called to go on mission for Jesus."

#### **INTRODUCING THE LESSON:**

It is not enough to talk about sowing seed or to think about preaching the Word of God, as we learned last week. We actually must do it! Our previous lesson helped prepare us for the work ahead, and make no mistake about it: there is plenty of work to do.

This week, we will see that Jesus sent His disciples out on a mission to sow the seed of God's Word. In doing so, He clearly indicated that it would certainly land on different kinds of soil. The challenges before them were many, but Jesus gave them authority and instructions that would help them in every circumstance they faced.

# **PRACTICAL POINTS:**

UNDAY

- 1. God provides resources to accomplish whatever tasks He assigns (Luke 9:1).
- 2. Effective Christian life and ministry balances physical and spiritual needs (Luke 9:2).
- 3. Trust God to provide so you can focus on being accessible to those who need Jesus (Luke 9:3-4).
- 4. Christians are responsible to deliver the gospel, while the hearers are responsible for how they respond to it (Luke 9:5-6).
- 5. If you are Christlike in your gospel ministry, you will become known for it (Luke 9:7-9).
- 6. Always rely on Christ in your gospel ministry by spending much time with the Lord in prayer (Luke 9:10).

#### **CONCLUDING THE LESSON:**

At the beginning of the lesson, did you notice what Jesus did before He equipped and sent the disciples out on their mission? He called them together. Always keep in mind that it is a mistake to go out and attempt to do anything for God without first coming to Jesus. Before we do the work of the Lord, we must submit to Him.
