## “Christ’s New Teachings”

*Lesson: Matthew 6:1-13*

### **GOLDEN TEXT:**

*“But when ye pray, use not vain repetitions, as the heathen do:...for your Father knoweth what things ye have need of, before ye ask Him.”  
— Matthew 6:7-8*

### **TODAY’S AIM:**

“To see clearly the teachings of Christ and their newness.”

### **INTRODUCING THE LESSON:**

In our last lesson, we saw the Lord Jesus quoting a previous command from God to which a rabbinic clause had been added and saying, “But I say unto you—” If He were not God, the third Person of the Godhead, that would be blasphemy. The authorities finally figured out that this was exactly what He was saying: He was in fact the Son of God. In their culture and belief system, that made Him equal to God. That was the charge on which they eventually condemned Him to death.

As far as we know, Christ was the first person to even hint at these teachings. We see the teachings as new when we compare them to the traditions of the elders and the Old Testament’s teachings from the Law and the Prophets. They were definitely new when He uttered them.

### **PRACTICAL POINTS:**

1. We should be genuine in our giving so that it benefits the recipients, not ourselves (Matthew 6:1).
2. It is wiser to let God reward you than to strive for the glory of men (Matthew 6:2).
3. All that matters is that God sees what you do, even if no one recognizes you for it (Matthew 6:3-4).
4. We pray to communicate with God, not to impress man (Matthew 6:5-6).
5. Trust God with your needs (Matthew 6:7-8).
6. If we want access to the power of God, we should follow Jesus’ example, when we approach Him (Matthew 6:9-13).

### **CONCLUDING THE LESSON:**

Not only are these teachings of Christ new, they are also completely the opposite of man’s imagination and reasoning. We cannot rely on our own thoughts or interpretations. We must rely on the clear teachings of the Lord Jesus Christ. He alone has the authority to teach us the truth.
