"The Altar, a Sign of Hope"

Lesson: Ezekiel 43:13-21

GOLDEN TEXT:

"These are the ordinances of the altar in the day when they shall make it, to offer burnt offerings thereon, and to sprinkle blood thereon (Ezekiel 43:18)

TODAY'S AIM:

"To see the significance of the altar in Israel's future worship."

INTRODUCING THE LESSON:

Because God's people had worshipped pagan gods and sinned against the Lord unrepentantly, God sent the Babylonians to destroy Jerusalem—the temple in particular—and to take the people into Babylonian service. While there, Ezekiel ministered to them by calling the idolaters back to the Lord and by offering comfort to the penitent.

During the Exile, Ezekiel saw the rebuilt future temple in a vision. It was a reminder that if only the people would repent, they would rebuild Jerusalem and its temple in the future. God commanded Ezekiel to describe the temple to His children so that their hearts would turn to Him.

PRACTICAL POINTS:

1. God's plans extend to the smallest details of life (Ezekiel 43:13-14).
2. We never need to guess what God wants us to do; we simply need to obey what He tells us (Ezekiel 43:15-17).
3. The concept of sacrifice is central to understanding the work of Christ (Ezekiel 43:18).
4. Those who serve as spiritual leaders of God's people must be especially careful to follow every detail of God's Word (Ezekiel 43:19).
5. Holiness must characterize every aspect of our worship (Ezekiel 43:20-21).

CONCLUDING THE LESSON:

"We must not let the unfamiliar nature of Old Testament worship, particularly its altar, dull our appreciation for the sincerity and seriousness of the people's worship. In concept, it was very much like our worship today. Their sin required an atoning sacrifice, even if it was only temporary. So did ours. Their daily service to God required that they carefully follow the laws of Leviticus. Our service to Christ is no less critical.

The altar served as a place to meet God in repentance for sin. No wonder we often call the front of our churches where we meet God the altar, although we must be careful in doing so! Whether it is the front of the church or the sacred place in our hearts where we go to meet our Savior, it is our sacred place, without which we remain far off from our Heavenly Father and His beloved Son, who died for our sins.
