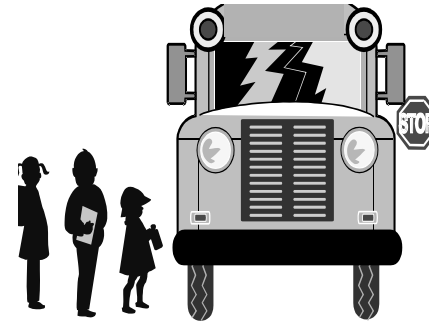


Church Van

"Restoration"

Lesson: Jeremiah 31:31-37

GOLDEN TEXT:

"The days come, saith the Lord, that I will make a new covenant with the house of Israel, and with the house of Judah" (Jeremiah 31:31).

TODAY'S AIM:

"To see why God proclaimed a new covenant through His messenger, Jeremiah."

INTRODUCING THE LESSON:

"God helps us understand our relationship with Him through the picture of a treaty, or covenant, between two nations in conflict. Because we are sinners, we have offended our Lord; this puts us in conflict with Him. The covenant shows us a way back to a right relationship with God.

Because conflict produces distrust, covenant and commitment to obedience go hand in hand. As we saw in the previous lesson (Jeremiah 30:1-3, 18-22), God gave His law for His people to obey.

A false prophet sent letters that preached rebellion against God and His law. God sent His Word through the Prophet Jeremiah to offer the hope of future restoration to His people in Babylon. Obedience was required. The message announced a new covenant. This lesson investigates the new covenant's content and function.

PRACTICAL POINTS:

1. God's mercy is evident in His dealings with Israel; He is not through with them (Jeremiah 31:31).
2. The new covenant is not dependent on Israel (or us) keeping the Mosaic Law (Jeremiah 31:32).
3. Knowing God is not a matter of memorizing and observing outward laws and rituals (Jeremiah 31:33).
4. Only God's forgiveness effectively deals with the problem of sin (Jeremiah 31:34).
5. The fulfillment of God's promises is secured by His power and faithfulness (Jeremiah 31:35-36).
6. Human sin does not invalidate God's faithfulness to Israel or to us (Jeremiah 31:37).

CONCLUDING THE LESSON:

"Jeremiah 31 should help Christians better understand the new covenant, in which they are participants. God's covenant describes His relationship with us in the language of conflict, for we were once far off from Him when He drew near to us in love.
